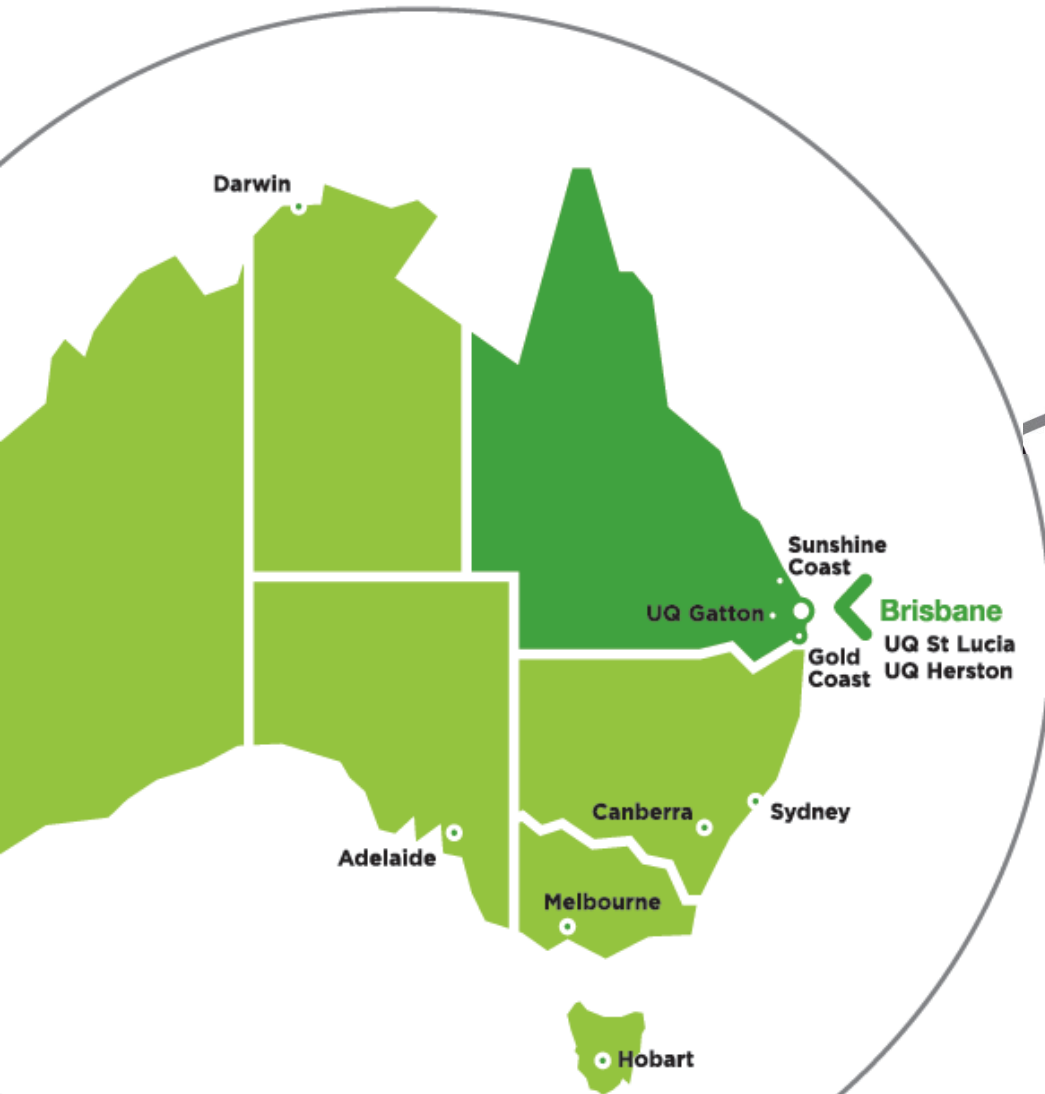

# UQ-TKU Partnership Scholarship

## Tuition Fee Waiver Scholarship

- One place: 50% of one semester of tuition fee waiver scholarship, not have an equivalent monetary value
- Only awarded in the student's first semester

## Eligibility

- Enrolled as the Master students that have the 1+1 articulation arrangement with UQ Faculty of Business, Economics and Law programs.
- Students who have completed at least one year of TKU above Master study with at least 85% (70%=pass) Students who have received an unconditional offer for a relevant UQ postgraduate program

## Application deadline

- 15 November for Semester 1, 2018 February commencement
- Have to be nominated by TKU College of Business and Management

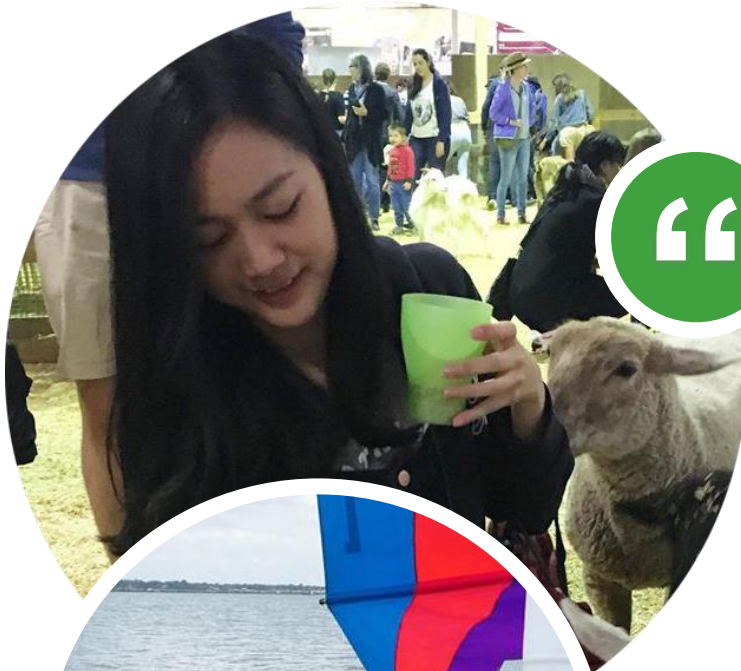

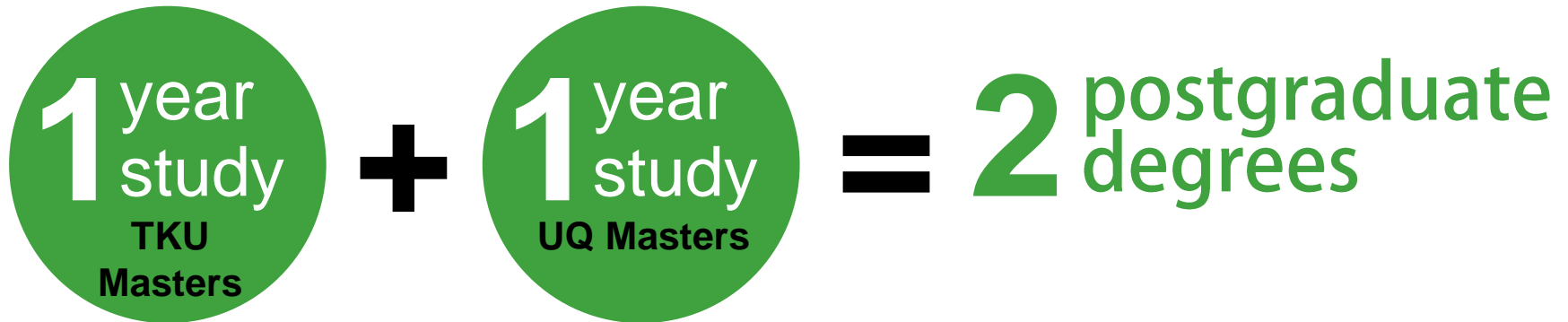

# Entry requirements

## Commencement

Semester 1 (February), or Semester 2 (July) each year

## Academic entry requirements for 1+1 into UQ BEL Faculty's 1.5 year Master programs

- Successfully completed bachelor degree [in the same discipline](#) with an average grade of at least of 70% (60% is a pass);
- Successfully completed a minimum 1 year of study in the Master program at the College of Business Management at Tamkang University with a passing average grade or above.

## English language proficiency requirements

IELTS 6.5 overall; 6 at least in all writing, reading, speaking and listening; OR  
TOEFL iBT 87 overall; 21 at least in writing; 19 at least in reading, speaking and listening

## Field of study

For students who have previously undertaken studies in business or commerce, entry will only be considered for a field **not already studied** (some exceptions may apply to accounting).

## Credit Transfer

students can obtain up to maximum of one semester credit (#8 units, 4 courses) for #24 unit (1.5yr) programs. Credit can only be granted for those courses that achieve a passing grade

- 10-weeks BEP Advantage (With **BEP Extension** 7 January 2019 – 4 February 2019: an opportunity to re-sit BEP assessment if failing the first one): 8 October 2018 – 17 December 2018
- 15-weeks BEP Standard: 8 October 2018 – 4 February 2019

### Dates for Semester 2, 2019 (February) degree entry

- 15-weeks BEP Advantage: 11 February 2019 - 27 May 2019
