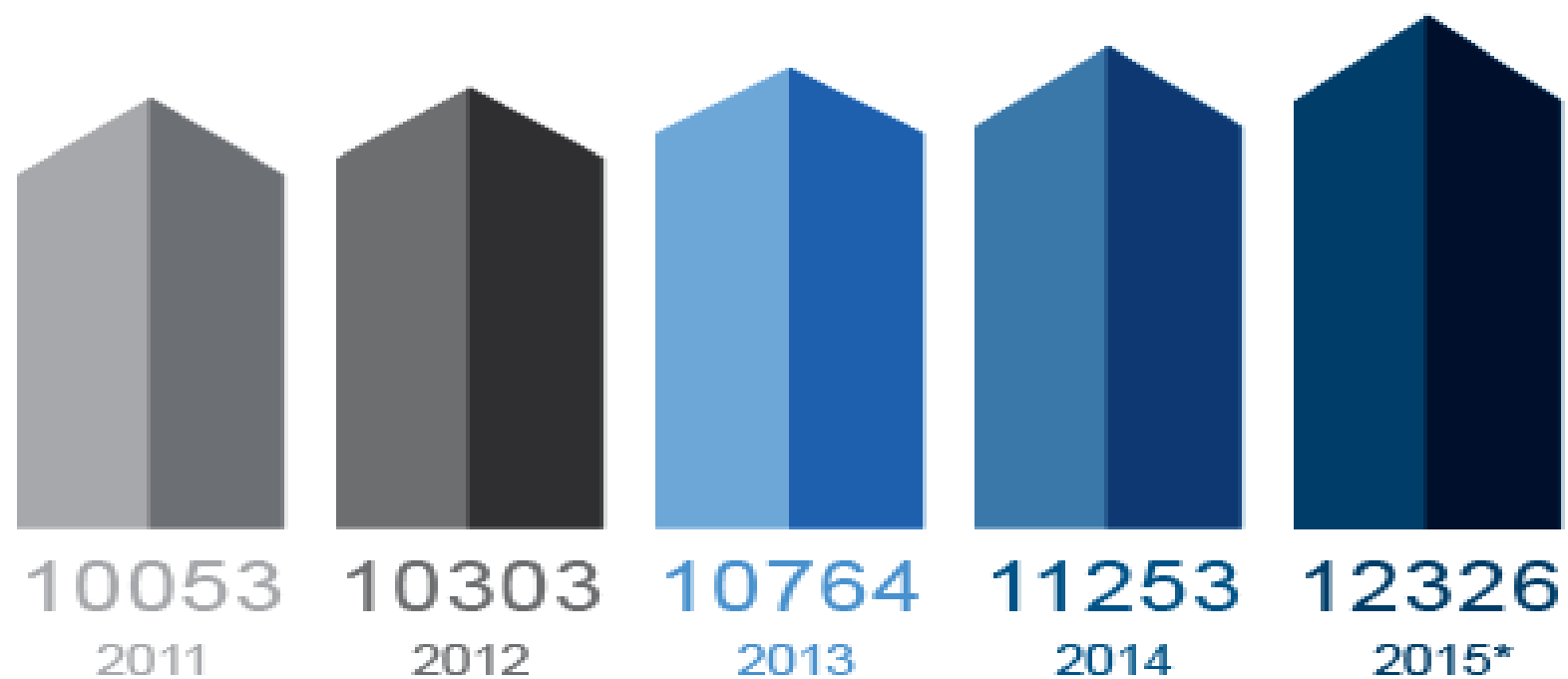

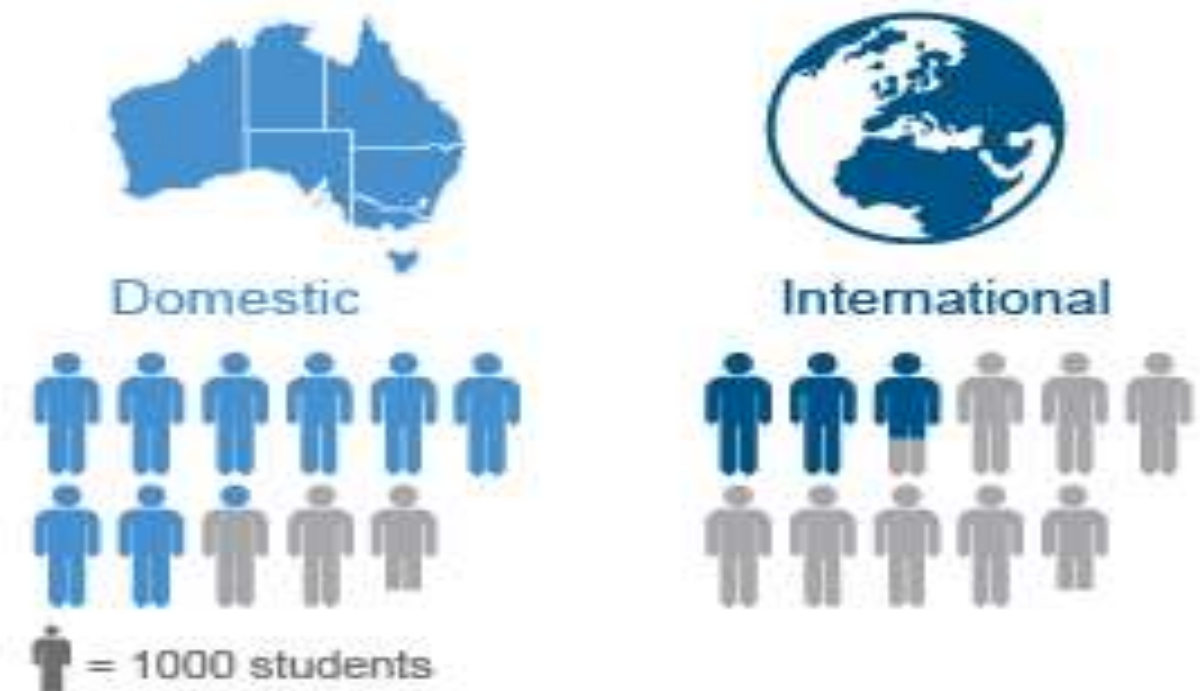
Student enrolment
