GLOBAL VILLAGE

Eligibility

- Undergraduate or graduate students native or fluent in speaking one of the following languages
 - English, Spanish, Chinese, German, Russian, Portuguese, Japanese, French, Arabic or Vietnamese
- Applications are only open to students participating in the Academic Program

Schedule

Period	June 17 - July 3, 2026 (3 weeks)
Orientation	June 18 - June 19, 2026 Participants will be given an information package containing materials for class instruction, books to use in class, schedule, etc. Orientation is mandatory for all participants.
Classes	June 22 - July 3, 2026 3 hours x 2 sessions daily x 10 days (Monday to Friday)
Teaching	Morning Session 9:00am - 12:00pm Afternoon Session 2:00pm - 5:00pm 6 hours a day - total 60 hours of teaching

Location

- Campus: Jukjeon or Cheonan
- Classes can be on either campus depending on the language being taught
- Teaching campus and peers will be assigned randomly

The Global Village is a unique teaching internship where participants teach conversational language to DKU students. Over three weeks, participants lead small-group classes in their native language, focusing on interactive learning and cultural exchange. The program offers a unique chance to build meaningful connections with local students while gaining firsthand insights into Korean culture. Plus, teaching is not only rewarding, it's a fantastic opportunity for participants to learn more about themselves and build valuable skills along the way.

Courses

Take up to 2 courses (3 credits per course)

Dates	Monday - Thursday, no classes on Fridays
Times	Morning Class 9:00 am - 12:00 pm Afternoon Class 1:00 pm - 4:00 pm
Hours	3 hours/day x 15 days = 45 hours/course
Subjects	East Asian studies, business, social sciences, IT, communication, history, global issues, fashion, Korean language, e-sports, martial arts, etc.
